Dear Consumers:

The Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) is amending the Developmental Disability Individual Budgeting Waiver to increase the adult day training rates and update the quality performance measures.

Also, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) passed a rule about how states offer Home and Community-Based Services. The new rule means you get your services from providers who:

- Work with you to make your plan of care;
- Make you feel at home if you live in a group home, assisted living facility, or adult family care home;
- Help you be part of your community; and
- Help you choose how you live and what you do.

The Agency is writing a preliminary transition plan to show CMS how our programs follow the new rule. Part of the preliminary transition plan includes asking the public for their feedback on the transition plan.
