TRAIN Florida is part of a national public health learning management network managed by the Public Health Foundation. The network currently includes the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Medical Reserve Corps (MRC), Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), and the Florida Department of Health, which collaborates with community partners, and universities.

Our new LMS will provide employees, support staff, families, and direct care staff with a web-based learning system. The TRAIN Florida LMS will allow each learner to interact with other state and federal agencies, local and national organizations, educational institutions, and our community partners.
