WHEREAS, organizations and advocates throughout Florida work with constituents and the community to bring forth the promises of hope and freedom that were envisioned by the passage of the ADA; and

WHEREAS, Florida ensures individuals with unique abilities are supported so they may live, work, and participate in their local communities; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2020, the State of Florida will celebrate the 30th Anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act with a virtual statewide ADA 30th Anniversary Celebration.
