CDC+ Representative Background Screening Requirement Reminder

All Consumer Directed Care Plus (CDC+) Representatives must comply with background screening requirements.

Florida law requires all CDC+ Representatives (excluding self-representatives), to undergo a background screening, pursuant to sections 409.221 and 393.0655, Florida Statutes (F.S.). Additional details are available in the Background Screening of CDC+ Representatives Advisory (dated August 1, 2025) on the CDC+webpage.

The chart below provides the due date for each CDC+ Representative to have successfully completed, passed, and submitted their level 2 background screening clearance to the CDC+ program, based on the Region that serves the CDC+ Consumer.

Southern	August 31, 2025	
Suncoast	September 30, 2025	
Southeast	October 31, 2025	
Northwest and Northeast	November 30, 2025	
Central	December 31, 2025	

Loss of CDC+ Representative

CDC+ Consumers who cannot or choose to not self-direct are required to always have a CDC+ Representative. CDC+ Consumers have 30 days to replace their CDC+ Representative if they cannot fulfill the requirements as outlined in the CDC+ Handbook. If a Consumer does not elect a new Representative within 30 days, the Consumer will be disenrolled from CDC+ and placed back on iBudget.

Clearinghouse Roster

Each person serving CDC+ Consumers, including CDC+ Representatives, MUST be on the consumer Clearinghouse Roster. Additionally, each non-waiver agency hired by the consumer must maintain their own Clearinghouse Roster, which must list every employee who provides services to a CDC+ Consumer. CDC+ Consumers/Representatives may, if they choose, request a copy of the non-waiver agency's roster to ensure that the agency's employees providing service to the consumer have been screened.

Consumer/Representative Email Address and Phone Number

Please make sure there is a current working email address and phone number on file for all active CDC+ Representatives and/or Consumers who are self-representatives. To ensure compliance with HIPAA laws and regulations, email addresses may not be the same as a provider's email address.

Florida Minimum Wage Increase Reminder

Effective September 30, 2025, Florida's minimum wage increases to \$14.00 per hour. If you currently have directly hired employees (DHEs) earning less than \$14.00 an hour, please be sure to submit an updated purchasing plan reflecting the rate increase, effective October 1, 2025. Please keep this wage increase in mind when negotiating new employee rates.
