PROVIDER ADVISORY #2024-009 UPCOMING ICONNECT LAUNCH FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE FUNCTIONALITIES

EFFECTIVE DATE: FEBRUARY 14, 2024

In case you missed the previous advisory, last week on February 8, 2024, the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) communicated upcoming training dates for the following functionalities that will go live in iConnect on **March 11, 2024.**

- Plans of Remediation
- Event Notifications

As a reminder, in addition to the self-paced training that is available in the TRAIN Florida platform, APD will provide live webinar and classroom iConnect Training from February 19 – March 8, 2024, to train impacted providers on the new functionality and in anticipation of Quality Assurance functionality going live in the system **March 11, 2024**.

All providers (including Qualified Organizations) will be impacted by this new functionality. Please note:

- Plans of Remediation will include identifying and responding to new note types and new ticklers in addition to updating the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) tab and items subpage where the plans of remediation are located.
- Event Notifications will include identifying and responding to new note types.
