APD Individual Rights and Challenges Training Course

Effective July 1, 2023, the Individual Rights and Challenges training course will be available in TRAIN Florida, found in the Individual Rights and Challenges Training Plan.

Audience

This course is an optional in-service training for new and existing residential providers and staff working in standard or behavioral APD-licensed foster and group homes.

Quizzes and Assessments

Participants must complete all module components to complete the course. There are five modules in the training course:

Module 1: The Bill of Rights of Persons with Developmental Disabilities

Module 2: Rights and Responsibilities

Module 3: Resident Government and House Rules

Module 4: HCBS Settings Rule, LRC, Rights Restrictions

Module 5: Balancing Individual Rights with Health and Safety, Community Integration, and Choice Making

Each module presentation will include practice quizzes that are **not** scored. At the end of each module presentation, participants will be directed to an assessment that **is** scored. Training participants must pass the assessment with a minimum score of 85%.
