UPCOMING APD ICONNECT TRAINING FOR ENROLLED SUPPORTED LIVING PROVIDERS

EFFECTIVE DATE: June 30, 2021

The Agency for Persons with Disabilities will be implementing APD iConnect Training for Supported Living Coaches starting in July 2021. Training invitations as well as registration information will be coming to Supported Living Coaching providers soon.

Supported Living Coaching will be the next iBudget waiver service to go live using APD iConnect later this summer. As a reminder, the iBudget Handbook requires that once services go live in iConnect, documentation required in accordance with Appendix A must be entered in APD iConnect confirming that a service has been rendered.

The training will be provided as an 8-hour live distance learning session that will be scheduled for either 1 full day or 2 consecutive half-days. All providers enrolled to render Supported Living Coaching services, agency and solo, should attend this training **regardless of whether the provider has a current service authorization for Supported Living Coaching**. Agency providers should register all supported living coaches working for the provider agency to attend.

In preparation for the Supported Living Coaching training sessions, participants who have not previously attended APD iConnect training will be required to complete pre-requisite courses in TRAIN FI, currently being finalized. Supported Living Coaches who took last year's APD iConnect training but have not yet successfully logged into APD iConnect to document service delivery for Personal Supports and/or Respite must complete this training in TRAIN FI. Supported Living Coaches who participated in last year's APD iConnect training that have successfully logged into APD iConnect to document service delivery for Personal Supports and/or Respite are encouraged to complete these TRAIN FI courses, even though it is not mandatory for them.
