

PROVIDER ADVISORY #2025-015
**ADULT DAY TRAINING AND PREVOCATIONAL SERVICES MONTHLY RATES – VOIDS,
ADJUSTMENTS, AND RECOUPMENTS**

ACTION REQUIRED

EFFECTIVE DATE: NOVEMBER 26, 2025 (UPDATED DECEMBER 1, 2025)

This communication is an update to [Provider Advisory #2025-14](#), issued on November 19, 2025, and provides additional guidance for providers billing for Adult Day Training (ADT) or Prevocational services.

As instructed in [Provider Advisory #2025-14](#), providers that have billed at the old ADT or Prevocational rate for services rendered after September 30, 2025, will need to adjust or void these claims and rebill at the new rate if the monthly rate is required. However, to allow time for new authorizations to be created with the new service codes, the Agency for Health Care Administration will suspend the automatic recoupment that occurs when a claim is voided or adjusted until April 1, 2026. This means that any claims voided or adjusted after December 2, 2025, will not be recouped and payments will not be impacted until April 1, 2026.

Beginning April 1, 2026, the Agency for Health Care Administration will begin recouping any outstanding balances associated with claims voided or adjusted since December 2, 2025.

Please note that all voided or adjusted claims after December 2, 2025, will have the recoupment suspended, not just claims for ADT and Prevocational services, for which recoupment will begin on April 1, 2026.
