KEY COMPLIANCE METRICS

- Insulin Log/MAR



CAN ADMINISTER OUTSIDE GROUP HOME?



YES

Nurses may administer insulin
in the group home and outside
the group home in accordance
with scope of practice.



NO

Administration is limited to
the group home setting.



YES-If MAP has completed APD
Insulin Administration Training.



NO-If MAP is only trained under
393.504 F.S. (within the group home
only).

KEY TAKEAWAY

Three lawful pathways exist for insulin administration in APD licensed group homes. Each pathway has different training requirements, oversight, documentation, and location limitations.
