Segregated settings such as state institutions are inherently less suited to high achievement in this measure as congregate living does not facilitate the consumers preference in many areas. As an example, a person in a state facility may not be readily connected to natural supports such as family since they are restricted to living in the areas where state facilities are located. It is important to note that the facilities have made significant improvement in this measure since inception. The implementation of legislative and policy changes relating to the sexual abuse of persons with disabilities will positively impact the performance of this measure by creating another means of ensuring resident safety and freedom from abuse. Management Efforts to Address Differences/Problems (check all that apply): Training Technology Other (Identify) Recommendations: The program is implementing the reduction in population of state facilities consistent with the Brown vs. Bush settlement agreement and is moving residents to less restrictive more integrated and cost effective settings.
